Motion carried.

## **Principal's Report**

- Kimberly Willison announced that Ms. Tyler received the School Bell Award from the Virginia Association of Elementary School Principals (VAESP). This award is presented to school-based principals, who are members of VAESP and have made significant contributions to their schools, school systems, state association, national association and/or other educational organizations.
- She also announced that 225 students participated in the Healthy Kids Fun Run. It was a great success and a big Thanks to all parents and teachers who helped make it possible.

### **Box Tops**

Barbara announced that the students did a great job collecting box tops and a check will be sent for \$790 in December. Discussion took place on how to utilize the money and we would like to purchase instructional games for the classrooms. Bruce Gordon motioned to approve purchasing games for the classes and the motion was seconded by Danica. Motion Carried.

Susan Crystal announced that Kung Fu Panda Movie Night is good to go. She has enough volunteers and all arrangements have been finalized. The SCA will have a box for the Food Drive available during movie night. We are asking each student to bring 1 can.

- Susan announced our new business partnership with the Fair Oaks Mall Chick-Fil A. There is no cost for the PTA and we will receive discounts on purchases in the future. We can host Spirit Nights there as well and our school will earn 20% from the receipts.
- Jamie Gadley presented a request for Funds from the PTA in the amount of \$600.00 to purchase insurance and have the route measured/certified for the First Eagle View 5k Fun Run. The tentative date is May 2, 2009 with a rain date of May 9, 2009. Jamie will coordinate establishing a committee and obtaining sponsorships. Motion to approve \$600.00 was made by Bruce. Motion was made by Dondi to approve. Motion seconded by Bruce. Motion carried.
